

So you're looking to commission an Illustration?

Great! But where to start?

Things I need to know

1

'our ideas! Please jot down all ideas you have, you can include ictures if you wish (this should not be of other illustrators work).

Time Scale! Do you require the work to be complete in a certain time scale? Often I will be working on multiple jobs and this helps for me to work out if I am able to schedule you in. It is important to note that short deadlines may mean an increase in fee.

ize! Do you require the artwork to be of a certain size? I.e. For an astagram post or a magazine article.

Use! What do you wish to use your illustration for? I.e. Is it for promotion for your products (it will be used multiple times) or a one off post on your social media? Why do I need to know this? This can determine the price of the illustration. **The use of your illustration** is called a licence.

A licence is a terms of use form (nothing scary!). It outlines the use of the illustrations and how you and I are protected i.e. That the illustration is exclusively yours to use and it also ensures that you are getting work that has not been copied. For example, I haven't just pinched an image of Google and sold it to you.



Process! Once ideas have been discussed I will send a series of 'roughs'. This helps us to see if we are happy with the idea and gives us the opportunity to iron out any issues before committing!
